Installation and maintenance

Technoflex 100% Acacia wood tiles offer the opportunity to change the look of your backyard, patio, balcony or deck at low cost, easily and without the need for professional intervention.




- Surface preparation:
 - The tiles must be laid on a flat surface. It is recommended to install them on a concrete slab.
 - Allow a slight slope of +/- 1cm for rainwater drainage.
 - Do not install on soft or damp ground (lawn or earth), as water retention will accelerate the deterioration of the wood.
- 2) Lay the tiles easily using the interlocking system:
 - The tiles can be laid indoors and outdoors.
 - They can be cut using a fine-toothed handsaw or jigsaw at low speed to achieve a clean cut.
 - Do not use a circular saw or grinder.
 - Assembling the tiles is simple and easy with the male and female interlocking system.
 - If possible, always start with a perfectly square corner (90°).
 - Start by positioning the two female sides of your first tile at a 90° angle, which will make it easier to fit the following tiles together.

Maintenance

- Wash with a soft, slightly damp cloth.
- Do not use detergents, solvents, or alcohol-based cleaners.
- For stubborn dirt, use a product suitable for oiled wood.

Protect and nourish the wood

- The tiles are pre-oiled for better moisture resistance.
- It is recommended to oil them upon installation and at the start of each season.
- Apply a new treatment as soon as the wood feels dry to the touch.
- Use only solvent-free exterior wood oils.
- Never use a wire brush or a pressure washer.



1 Year limited warranty

- It is the customer responsibility to ensure that the product and its intended use are compliant.
- The warranty is valid for 1 year following the purchased date and upon proof of purchase.
- The warranty covers only the defective parts that require replacement.
- Technoflex undertakes to provide new parts as quickly as possible.
- The warranty does not cover: shipping costs, travel, labor, communication or fee related to a claim, and direct and indirect damages.
- Size variations of +/- 2 to 3 % due to climatic conditions are considered normal and are not guaranteed.
- IMPORTANT: Wood is a living material that expands and contracts over time. You may see cracks appear over time, but these do not affect the product's lifespan.
